

I Edward Sigler of the County of Hanover, State of Virginia
temporarily residing in Richmond in consequence of the unhappy
war with the North, do hereby make my last will and testament
in manner and form following that is to say;

1st I desire to be buried in plain Coffin of pine or poplar.

2^{dly} I desire all of my just debts paid.

3^{dly} I desire no sale of my personal effects unless deemed ex-
pedient by my Executive herein after named.

4^{thly} After the payment of my debts & funeral expenses I bequeath
to my wife Sarah Elizabeth all of the real estate in the City of
Richmond which she inherited from her mother Mary Land.

5^{thly} I bequeath to my son Stephen C. Sigler all of my land
estate in the County of Hanover except two acres which I have previously
given to the Church so long as it may be useful for, or use
for that purpose.

6^{thly} I desire my Slaves divided into three equal parts or lots
my wife Sarah Elizabeth to have choice of one part or lot for her
portion the remaining two parts or lots for my son Stephen C. Sigler
all of my furniture Stock &c to be equally divided between my wife Sarah
Elizabeth & my son Stephen C. Sigler.

Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my wife Sarah Elizabeth
Executor of this my last will and testament with all the powers
required to give it effect.

5thly. I bequeath to my Son Stephen C. Johnson all of my real
estate in the County of Hanover except two acres. One in Wal-
nut Grove Church Streets which two acres I have previously
given to the Church so long as it may be useful for or used
for that purpose.

6thly I desire my Slaves divided into three equal portions lots
my wife Sarah Elizabeth to have choice of one part in lots for her
portion the remaining two parts in lots for my Son Stephen C. Johnson
all of my furniture Stock &c to be equally divided between my wife Sarah
Elizabeth & my Son Stephen C. Johnson.

Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my wife Sarah Elizabeth
Executor of this my last will and Testament without being
required to give Security. In witness whereof I have this
day Subscribed with my hand and Seal.

Witness my hand and Seal this 1st day of May 1868.

At a Court of Monthly Session held for Henrico County at the Court
house on Tuesday the 21st of October 1865

This last will and Testament of Edward Sydnor deceased and
the Codicil thereon written was offered for proof by Sarah E. Sydnor
the Executrix in the said will named and there being no Subscribing wit-
nesses to the said will or Codicil and James M. Ladd and Nathan B. Clarke
being sworn and examined declare that they do well agree with the
hand writing of the said Edward Sydnor deceased that they have examined
the said will and Codicil and are by believe the same to have been actually
written and subscribed by the said Edward Sydnor deceased. Whereupon the
Court doth order the said will and Codicil to be recorded as the last will
and Testament of the said Edward Sydnor deceased.
