Item the first I wish and desire that all my just debts
shall be first paid

Item the second, That my Executors shall sell the surplus
property on my farm taking care to retain a full supply
of plantation tools and stock for a support of the same farm
for twelve months after this shall go into effect. I leave to my
wife Martha B. Clough all my real and personal Estate during her life.
In case she leaves issue begotten of the body by me then in that case
at her death shall be equally divided among them but in case
at her death she leaves none it is my wish and desire that my
Executor shall sell all of my estate both real and personal
and divide the proceeds equally between the daughters of my
deceased son then may be living also Martha B. Dickinson daugh-
ter then living and Virginia Thomas.

I give to Lucy Clough should she be living five hundred dollars.
In case the surplus property on my said farm is not sufficient
to pay my just debts. it is my wish and desire that my Execu-
tors shall sell William Anderson and William Green who are
now hired in the City of Richmond. I appoint Charles C. Insley
and Charles Rhoads my Executors as witnesses my hand and
Seal this 9th day of September 1847.
