

I Henry Kersey do hereby make this my last will & testament in manner and form following that is to say
After the payment of all my just debts and funeral expenses
1st I give and bequeath to my wife Polly W. Kersey during her life all that ~~portion~~ ^{side} of my Farm upon which I at present reside lying upon the South ^{Side} of the Va. C. R. Road with every thing upon it, at death of my said wife my will and desire is that the land go to my daughter Mary C. Brady or her Child or Children & should she be dead and leave no Child or Children to be equally divided between my Brothers & Sisters or their legal representatives
2nd I give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary C. Brady all that portion of my Farm lying upon the North Side of the Va. C. R. Road during her life, at the time of her death if she has a Child or Children to them in fee simple, if she has none then in the same way as in Item the first, it is my will that the House now commenced and not finished upon the said loaned be finished and paid for out of my estate.
3rd The Crop now growing and being cultivated upon Charles Diggins land I give and bequeath to my wife Polly W. Kersey in fee simple.
4th My will and desire is that all my bonds & shall remain loan out as they are at present so long as the interest is punctually paid and my representatives may consider them safely invested, the interest so accruing annually

should she be dead and leave no child or children to be equal
divided between my Brothers & Sisters in their legal representation
2nd I give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary (Bridget) or
that portion of my Farm lying upon the North Side of the
Ga. C. Road during her life, at the time of her death if she
has a child or children to them in fee simple, if she has none
then in the same way as in Item the first. It is my will
that the House now commenced and not finished upon the said
loaned be finished and paid for out of my estate.
3rd The Crop now growing and being cultivated upon Charles Dypson's
land I give and bequeath to my wife Polly & Hersey in fee
simple.
4th My will and desire is that all my bonds I have remain
loan out as they are at present so long as the interest is paid
regularly paid and my representatives may consider them safely
invested. the interest so accruing annually I give and bequeath
to my said wife Polly W in fee simple during her life. at the
death of my said wife I give the interest accruing as above to
my Daughter Mary (Bridget) in fee simple during her natural
life. at the death of my said daughter I give the principal to
her child or children if she has any of more than to my
Brothers & Sisters in their legal representation. If it may
be in the State at the time of my death.

Said wife Polly W. to use for the benefit of my family
5th lastly I constitute and appoint my wife & daughter
John L. Depew Executor of this my last will & test-
