I John Stacks of Hanover County, being of sound &
disposing mind & body, do make this to be my last
will & testament as follows

I desire that my body may be buried at the discre-
tion of my Executors, hereinafter named & I direct that
all my just debts be paid out of my estate as soon
after my decease as may be convenient.

First I give to my Grandson Joseph Stacks, the only child
of my deceased daughter Virginia Stacks one dollar &
this is all I wish him to have in addition to what I
have given my said daughter.

Secondly, I give to my beloved wife during her life, the
balance of my estate both real & personal, & at her
death I wish my said estate divided equally equally
between my daughters Delia F. Stacks Adeline Head, the
wife of John Head and Charlotte Stacks and if either of
my said daughters die with out issue I direct their share
of my estate to return to my surviving children.

Third I do hereby nominate & appoint John Stacks, Hanover County, Va. as my Executor.

Stark to be Executor of this my last will and
testament.

In witness whereof, I the said Jno Stark, have to
this my last will set my hand & seal this day
of in the year 1828.
