burial and funeral expenses I wish my little estate to be divided
into five equal parts and distributed as follows

Item 5th The first part to my Son William G. Utley

Item 6th The second part to my son Thos J Utley

Item 7th The third part to my Daughter Mary Jane Utley

Item 8th The fourth part to my Grand Daughter Sarah C Utley
or Child of my son Gordon S Utley

Item 9th The fifth part to my Daughters Pauline A Foster solely
for her benefit or the benefit of the heirs of her body however or in
trust in the hands of my son Wm G. Utley not to be in any way
subject to the control of Ambrose Foster
