Joseph A. Boche of the County of Hanover and Parish of
Saint Paul do hereby make this my last will and
testament in manner and form following, that is to say
I desire that all the perishable part of my property be
immediately sold after my decease and only the money arising
therefrom: All my just debts be paid. Should the perishable part
of my property prove insufficient for the above purposes then
I desire that my administrators hereafter named may sell my
real estate and out of the money arising therefrom pay and
satisfy such of my just debts as shall remain unpaid out
of the perishable part of my estate.
And after the payment of my just debts all the rest of my
estate both real and personal together with the money arising
from said sale I desire may be equally divided between my
children, to-wit: Joseph A. Boche, Jr. and Paul A. Boche.

will be so and their heirs forever in absolute fee
simples.

They do hereby constitute and appoint my friends Joseph
Wingfield and Samuel Peim my administrators of this my
last will and testament hereby revoking all others in former
wills or testaments by me heretofore made in testimony whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this second
day of March one thousand eight hundred and twenty three
