Copy of the Will of Josephine Maicault Pisat.

In the name of God Amen

I the undersigned Josephine, Maicault Pisat the widow of
Michael Pisat of Hoboken in the County of Hudson and
State of New Jersey being of sound and disposing mind and
Memory and desirous of settling my worldly affairs which I have
Strength and Capacity to make, declare and publish this my last
Will and Testament in the following manner

1st I order my funeral expenses and all my just debts to
be paid by my Executors herein after named out of my estate
as soon as conveniently possible

2nd To my daughter Adèle in consideration of her kind attentions
to me I give and devise, my clock and Chair Bed and bedding
all my dresses and one half of my linen

3rd To my Son Leonor in Acknowledgment of his good services

Care and kind regards toward me for many years.

I give devise and bequeath one quarter of the Amount which shall or may be Realized out of my property in Virginia.

4th Whereas I have advanced some money to my Son Alfred for which he has regularly paid me the interest and partially reimbursed the principal. About eight hundred dollars whereof remaining due me now. It is my will and desire that said Son Alfred should account to my wife for whatever amount of the said advanced money remaining due me at my decease.

5th After the Executors of the Will and Conditions herebefore mentioned I give devise and bequeath unto my five children, Leander Alfred, Joseph Adile & Louise the residue of all the real and personal estate I shall or may be possessed of at my decease to be divided among them share and share alike.

6th In case of the decease of any said five children intestate and without issue I desire that the same

Before the final distribution of my estate. It is my desire
that the residue of my estate referred to in the last above
mentioned should be divided among the survivors of them, those and
those alike, and in case any of my said four children
should die leaving issue his or her share to go to
such issue.

I constitute, name and appoint as the executors of this
last Will and Testament my sons Leonce, Ricard and
Graft, Ricard or either of them who shall and take upon
himself the execution thereof with full power to sell
convey or otherwise to both of them jointly to the survivor of them or to either of them
separately in case either of them should neglect or refuse to qualify as
executors within a reasonable time after the probate and
recording of this my last Will.
