A Copy of the Will of Maria W. Pate

Maria W. Pate of the County of Kanawha and State of Virginia
do hereby make this my last Will and Testament in manner and form fol-
lowing, revoking all other Wills heretofore made.
I give to my son John W. Pate the interest in the real estate
of this father which he the said John W. Pate has heretofore be-
come conveyed to me upon the condition that he pay all
the money for which I am liable, to pay as his security
I give to my son William B. and my daughter Rebecca C.
and Maria A. Pate, all my household and kitchen furniture
all my other other personal estate of every kind including all
my debts to be equally divided between them.
And lastly, I appoint my son John W. Pate, Executor of
this my last Will requesting that no Security be required of
him by the Court.
