Copy of the Will of Nathaniel Bower.

In the name of God. Amen.

I Nathaniel Bower of the County of Hancock, being of sound
and disposing mind and memory do hereby make and declare
this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all other
Wills by me heretofore made.

Item. I give and bequeath unto my Wife Annanna Bower
One third of my whole estate real & personal the real estate
to be allotted her, so as to embrace the dwelling and other
messuag out houses thereto attached. This bequest herein
is to be terminated with natural life of the said Annanna
Bower. It is my Will, that the balance of my estate real &
personal be divided into three equal parts the real estate as
commonly as may be, having regard to its value, one equal
part of my estate real and personal, I give and devise to

Trust to Benjamin Wingfield Esqr for the sole and
exclusive benefit of my daughter Susanna M. Perrin
Wife of Daniel Perrin and her Children which she now
has or may hereafter have, by her marriage with the said
Perrin. And I hereby invest the said Trustee with power
to sell or exchange any of the said property as he may
think conducive to the interest of the said Susanna
M. Perrin and her Children.

This trust however is to terminate with the death of the
said Daniel Perrin where the property hereby bequeathed and
devise shall become the absolute estate in fee simple
of the said Susanna Perrin or of her Children when
the said Susanna shall die.

Given at my last and only will and testament
this 10th day of June 1850

and her heirs forever.

I give and devise one other equal part of my Estate
real and personal to my daughter Hannah Davis to her and
her heirs forever.

I give and devise unto my daughter Emily D. Davis

other equal part of my estate real and personal to her
her heirs forever

I give and devise unto my Son Nathaniel J. Boore
other equal part of my estate real & personal to him
his heirs forever

I give and devise unto my Son Hector, Boore the other
part of my estate real, and personal to him & his heirs

It is my Will that, that part of my estate left my
during her life I shall at her death in like manner
divided into eleven equal parts one whereof I give
in trust to Benjamin, Whingfield Gay for the
and exclusive use and benefit of my daughter
Mrs. Quinn wife of Samuel Quinn, and
children upon the same limitations and
conditions as contained in the second clause.

of this my Will. The residue I give and devise in several parts
to such of my children as may then be alive or to the
children of those who may have died.

Item. I hereby constitute and appoint, my sons Nathaniel
Flaming, Bower, and Hector Bower Executors of this my
last Will, In Testimony whereof I Nathaniel Bower have
hereunto set my hand & seal this 21st day of Novr 1829.
