publish and declare this as my last will and Testament in manner
and form following viz:

Where My will and desire is that my Executor or Executors herein
After Named, shall at my death sell by public Auction or otherwise
the tract of land wherein I now live and also ^{all} my personal estate and
out of the proceeds thereof pay all my just debts & funeral expenses
and the balance to be divided in manner following To wit:

One third part thereof to my wife Mary M^c Cook and the remaining
two thirds again to be divided one half thereof to my Son Nathl
M^c Cook and one third part of the remaining balance to my Son
Thomas O. M^c Cook one third to my Son Charles M^c Cook
and one third to be divided between my grandsons Benjamin
and Andrew Hutton.

I do hereby constitute and appoint Charles P. Goodall and
William Wingfield Jr as Executors to this my last will and
Testament hereby revoking all others, heretofore made by me.
September 5th 1835. Meah. Mc Cook.
