In the name of God Amen. I Patrick W. Dimes of Louisiana County do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following.

Imprimis 1st I give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Wardina one negro boy named Julia to her heirs & forever.

Items 2nd I also give to my beloved Wife Wardina as a return for her affectionate regard fifty dollars to be paid by my Executors herein after mentioned out of any sale of my estate twelve months after my decease.

Items 3rd The balance and residue of my estate of every kind I give (my just debt being first paid) I give to my beloved mother during her natural life and after her decease I give the same to my beloved brother Garland L. Dimes. But in case he the said Garland L. Dimes should die without lawful

As the said Edward L. Davis should die without lawful
issue he or heirs I give the said estate to my Cares
Francis M. Gaudin and Margaret Thompson Children
of Nathl Thompson Jr to them and their heirs forever.
I do hereby and appoint Nathl Thompson Jr my Executor
