Copy of the Will of Peter Lyons.

The name of that Amen; I, Peter, Lyons of the County of Henneper
now in Richmond, do make this my last Will and Testament
in manner and form following, to wit.

In the payment of my just debts I give to my sister all my estate
real and personal provided she does not marry Mr. Williams Rogers,
if she does so, I give farm called Studley to L. A. Roemer daughter of
friend W. H. Roemer farmer. and the rest of my Estate of whatever
it may be, both real and personal I wish to be equally divided
among my friends, Doctor L. W. Chamberlaine and George T. Camp
my negro Slave Edmond and old Judy and I wish them set free
as the law will permit, and I also wish old Judy supported out of
estate. I appoint my friend P. B. Winston of Henneper County
executor, to this my last Will and Testament.
