Hanover State of Virginia, being at this time of sound mind and
health of body do constitute the following my last Will and Testa-
ment in manner and form following to wit: My Will is that after
my death, all of my just debts be paid.

Item Second - My Will is and I give to my daughter (the daughter of
James M. Miller) one feather bed.

Item Third. My Will is and give to my Nephew John Samuel Pumpap
all of my Real estate, that is to say, all of my portion of the
land on which I now reside and all of my personal Estate consisting
of Stock, farming utensils, household and Kitchen furniture except
the feather bed which I have given to Fannie Miller herein before
mentioned and hereby proclaim the above my last Will and
Testament hereby revoking all other Wills heretofore made by me in
testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my
seal this 25th day of July 1861 in the presence of the
following witnesses.
