Copy of the Will of Reuben Sord.

Reuben Sord of the County of Hanover make and contain
my last, will and testament. I leave to my wife during her
widowhood all my landed estate, my stock of every kind together
with the household and kitchen furniture and utensils
but upon her marriage or death I devise the whole of
the property above mentioned to my two sons Patrick & Reuben
Sord. and in the event of either Patrick or
Reuben dying under age or without issue the said property
to go to the survivors of them.
I give that one quarter of an acre of the land on which I now reside
to be reserved around the grave yard for burial purposes.
I give my carpenters, tools, of every kind, to two sons - Patrick
and Reuben. I give to my daughter Melinda Durre and
Lucinda Slaughter five dollars each.

All other money of which I may be possessed in bonds notes or
otherwise I bequeath to my two Sons Patrick and Reuben to
be expended by my Executor in a judicious manner upon their
education. I appoint my wife Lucy Lord Executor and my
son Joseph Thomas Executor of this my last will and
testament under my hand this 17th of February 1852.
