perfect memory blest be Almighty God for the same, do make
publish this my last will and Testament, in manner and form
following

First, I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Anna G. O.
Todd, every thing contained in a deed of Gift heretofore made
by me and is now on record in Spotsylvania Court. I do also
give and bequeath unto her all the personal property that I now
possess in any of the States I do also give her my interest in
a Tract of land lying on Duck Creek in Robertson Co. For as
I do also give and bequeath unto my Youngest Son Samuel

Dick Todd. my Tract of land in Rush Co Texas, sold by Dewey McComby & wife to James Tuller and afterwards conveyed to me by his executors. I do also give him my interest in a Tract of land in Portland and Wharton Counties Texas as deeded to D. D. Atchison by Ogle, information can be had by referring to the transaction between Atchison & Ogle or Atchison & myself. I have a contract with Maj James S. Holman by which I hold a Tract of land lying in Jasper Co Texas said to contain about five thousand acres which said Tract of land after coming into the hands of my executor, may be divided as follows. First I give and bequeath unto the heirs of my daughter Miss Jane Smith one thousand acres of the Tract of land in Jasper Co. I do also give and bequeath unto my daughter Eliza Brier & her Children one thousand acres of the said Tract of land, I do also give her & her Children my interest in my Sister Betsey. estate supposed to be about four hundred dollars, — I do also give my nephew Samuel Todd son of my brother Levy Todd one hundred acres of the Tract of land above mentioned. My son James H. Todd has heretofore received a portion of my land in Rush Co. and various others property and money and therefore will receive no further donation not knowing at this time whether he is dead or alive. My son John A. Todd (who is now dead) having received such portion of my estate in his life time as will justify me in withholding any further donation from his heirs or assigns. I do also give and bequeath unto my son the said Samuel Dick Todd, a land which I hold on Jos. H. Street, Chastam White, and William L. White for of one thousand dollars which I bequeath from

Dick Todd, a bond which I hold on, Jos. R. Street, Cashier there,
and William L. White Jr. of one thousand dollars, with interest from
the 22nd April 1864 of loaned money when the banks were paying
Specie. I do also give him a bond I hold on J. L. Marks of Louisiana
for Eleven hundred and eighty, six dollars & fifty seven and a half
cents bearing interest from March 1st 1864 at the rate of eight per cent.
I do also give and bequeath unto my granddaughter Mary Lou Greer,
five hundred acres of the said tract of land in Jasper Co. St. Clusive
of her interest in the thousand acres already given to her mothers
children, The remaining portion of the said tract of land (about twenty
five hundred acres) I do also give and bequeath unto my son
the said Saml. D. Todd. All of my honest debts which are but few,
must be paid and after that I see no necessity of any public sale
of my property. I hereby appoint my son Saml. D. Todd sole executor
of this my last will & Testament (not requiring him to give any
security whatever) hereby revoking all former wills by me made, In
witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 29th
day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hun
dred and sixty six.
