- 2nd I wish my funeral expenses to be paid
- 3rd I give to my brother William White four hundred dollars
- 4th I give to my sister Eliza J. M. Dowell four hundred dollars
- 5th I give to my niece Menerva A. Pleasants four hundred dollars
- 6th I give to my niece Eliza M. Montgomery four hundred dollars
- 7th I give to my nephews Joseph Patrick Williamson Patton, and Joseph R. White one hundred each
- 8th I give to Mr. American Anthony one hundred dollars
- 9th I give to my niece Catharine A. Croft Two hundred & fifty dollars to do as she thinks proper with
- 10th I give my nephews & nieces Silas L. M. Dowell Alice J. M. Dowell, Oliver J. M. Dowell, Lucine A. M. Dowell & William Soule M. Dowell Two hundred & fifty dollars each
- 11th If the property coming from my brother William White's estate with all my other property should be more than a Sufficiency to settle the above legates the balance of the property to be equally divided between my brother & sister nephews & nieces above named

& Sister nephews & nieces above named and if there shall be a deficiency there shall be a reduction in the same proportion

12th I have two farm & two Cotton Counterpane I give to my four nieces, Catharine A. Croft Eliza M. Montgomery Alice J. McDowell & Perine A. McDowell one each

13th The balance of my property to be sold publicly and distributed in proportion as the above

I appoint John L. McDowell & Charles P. Montgomery as Executors of this my last Will and Testament
