Copy of the Will of Thomas B. Quinn.

In the name of God Amen.

I Thomas B. Quinn of the County of Henrico and State of Virginia do make this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all other Wills by me made.

Item 1st. It is my wish and desire that my executor hereinafter named shall pay all my just debts.

Item 2nd. After the payment of my debts, when my youngest child Thomas B. Quinn shall arrive at the age of twenty one years, it is my will and desire that the residue of my estate Real and personal should be equally divided between my three children John W. Robert and Thomas B. Quinn.

Item 3rd. I hereby appoint my friend John B. Patterson Executor of this my last Will and Testament.

Witness my hand and Seal this day of April 1859.

Item 2.nd After the payment of my debts, when my youngest child
Thomas B. Dunn shall arrive at the age of Twenty one years, it is
my will and desire that the residue of my estate Real and personal should
be equally divided between my three children John. H. Robert, and
Thomas B. Dunn.

Item 3.rd I hereby appoint my friend John B. Patterson Executor
of this my last will and testament.
