A copy of the will of William Bowe.

William Bowe of the County of Worcester do Enstate this my Will.
I give Polly the daughter of Susanna Jones a negro girl called
my will. I give William the son of the said Susanna two
hundred dollars for the purpose of assisting him in his schooling and
to Susanna Jones a negro man called Dick a Cow & my
old yard & garden where I now live, with the privilege of getting
wood and fruit.

I give my land on Totoponey, Bucks together with land I got by my
father John and a tract called Butlers to be equally divided
among Susanna Jones's six children known and called by the
following names to wit. Isaac, Sally, Polly, Nancy, Albert & John.
I give the balance of my estate of every description to be
equally divided amongst the before mentioned six children what I lent
Susanna Jones at her death is to be for her children.

Samuel Jones all his death is to be for his children.

I Samuel Jones of Richmond and Henry W. Timberlake of
Honover my executors to execute this my last will.
