Copy of the Will of William Bowles.

William Bowles now, of Harrow County being of Sound Sense and
Mind, memory do constitute and make this my last Will and
Testament in manner following to wit:
First. Recommending my Soul to the Almighty God.
Secondly. I give and bequeath forever to my Brother Jonathan
Bowles, my Bridal, and Saddle and all my wearing apparel.
Thirdly. I give and bequeath forever to my brother Saml. I have
the Old Witch.
Fourthly. I give and bequeath to my Daughter, Harriet Bowles
one half of all my estate both real and personal, but if she should
die before she becomes of lawful age or marries then in that case
all goes to my wife Susanna Bowles forever.
Fifthly. I give to my beloved wife Susanna, Bowles one half of all
my estate both real, and personal, during her natural life and

To go to my Daughter Harriet, Dawles, but be it remembered if
Daughter Harriet, Dawles should before she becomes of lawful age
marries so that my wife Susanna Dawles, has all my estate, Then
that case Susanna Dawles is first to pay my sister Ann Figners
one thousand, dollars which said thousand dollars is to be
equally divided amongst her the said Ann Figners children.
I do appoint my wife Susanna Dawles and my
other Son and I bequeath my whole and sole estate
of paying to my sister Ann Figners money sufficient or
enough to pay her with regard to the said of mourning clothes, the whole
the above legacies is given in taken for the natural loss,
have for them, after the above legacies is paid and delivered,
all my just debts is also to be paid and then ever paid to
disposed of agreeable to the true meaning of this my
last Will. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and seal this, ninth day of December one thousand
eight hundred and seven

At a Court of monthly Session held for Hanover County at
the Court house on Wednesday the 3rd of December 1805 this last
Will and Testament of William Dauls decd was offered for proof
by Susanna Dauls the Executrix therein named and Samuel J
Kettlett the Executor therein named and was proved by the oaths
of John Hatter and Fanny Fenderson the witnesses thereto
and also by the oaths of the said Executrix & Executor and
is ordered to be recorded.
