In the name of God amen.

I William Coker of the Parish of Saint Paul in the County of
more do make this my last Will and Testament.

I bind unto my daughter Ruth Coker the former Negro -
and David, George, Peggy & Hannah and at her death it is my
will God desire that the said Ruth With the entourage of the females
to be equally divided among the children of my said daughter
she may be alive at her death, but in case any of her children shall
die her life time bearing issue that such issue shall have
part of their parent had he or she deceased at the time
the death of my said daughter.

I give and bequeath unto my son in law Richard P.
each full head of sheep.

I give and bequeath unto my son in law Horace Fleet
three negro slaves to wit, Betty, Betty and Lewis, one

Mr. Gandy and Company into my hands in soon coming over
three negro slaves to Miss, Betty Bell and Lewis, one
and five head of sheep to him and his sons forever -
Mr. Gandy and Company into my hands William Becker my
slaves to Miss James Robert and Alfred, one horse, one
and five head of sheep and a bed and furniture to him
to his heirs forever.

I had left my beloved wife during her life the tract
and whom I now reside all the plantation consists the
size of all kinds the household and kitchen furniture and the -
not before mentioned and the following slaves to Mr. John.
John, Nelson, Stephen, Ben, Egg, Pekoda, George and -

and it is my will and desire that my wife pay my
the cost of the Bedstead and Furniture but the aforesaid.

The death of my wife 5 years with my good Anna Becker
and young son George Becker Becker gave
her to be buried in the yard of the church
in the town of Becker.

I said I give and bequeath unto my son William and
to his heirs forever, and the balance of my estate last to my
wife as aforesaid I give and bequeath unto my three children
Sarah Camp, Captain John and William Gorder to be
equally divided between them to their and their heirs forever
and whereas it is uncertain whether my said sons John and
Anderson Gorder be now alive or not, least in case he shall
return, then I give him at my Wifes death one half of my said
land of land and the said brothers Nat Gorder and Nelson
to have and to hold forever land in the event of his
returning. I do hereby resolve this donee to his said daughters
as aforesaid.

Item. Whereas I have heretofore given unto some of my children
some property by way of advancement I do now hereby confirm
such gifts to them and their heirs forever.
Lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my son William
Gorder and my sons in law Richard P. Lampard and James
