Item. After the death of my wife I give to my daughter, Sarah W. Turner and my son Alonzo C. Turner five hundred dollars to be equally divided between them.

Item, The balance of my estate both real and personal I wish to be equally divided between all my children.

Lastley and finely I constitute my wife Ann W. Turner Executrise to this my last will and testament given under my hand and seal this 12th day of November 1836.
