

I William White of the County of Hanover do make & ordain this my last will. I lend unto my wife Caty the Land whereon I now live together with all the negroes Stock and other property which I may see proper of out of which she is to pay my debts and the following legacies Viz. To my Son Richard Baylor four hundred dollars worth of negroes ^{or more} as convenient after my death. To my Children Ann Thomas, Millicent Elizabeth, Alice, Lipscombe Helen, Warner, Silas, Eliza each four hundred dollars worth of negroes as they become of age or marry. At the death of my wife, I give the land whereon I now live to my Sons James Thomas & Edmund to be divided by a line running from the corner near the barn to an iron corner Stone on Nat Dickinsons line James Thomas to have the part on which the house stands. I give the Land which I bought of Foster to my Son Lewis B. White I give the land which I bought of John Smith in Spotsylvania to my Son William. The property left by my wife at her death after paying the above mentioned legacies to be equally divided among all my Children. I appoint my Sons Richard Baylor Lewis B. & William White Executors of this my last will test my hand and Seal this 20th of Nov. 1862.
