

I, William O. Winston of the County of Hanover being in the perfect exercise of my understanding do make and ordain this to be my last will and Testament hereby revoking all wills by me heretofore made.

1st Item It is my wish that my Executors as soon as practicable after my death pay off all my just debts. It is further my wish that the Statute of Limitations shall not be pleaded by my Executors to any debt which I may justly owe.

2^d Item. I give and bequeath to my wife Sarah A. Winston my Slaves Edman and Amey Three hundred and fifty Dollars the amount realized from the sale of my my gold watch and chain and my Chamber furniture of every description including winter & Summer Curtains and the Covering used upon the bed and things to her and her heirs in fee simple forever.

3^d Item - I give and bequeath to my Son Philip B. Winston my Turkey Gun to him and his heirs forever.

4th Item. I give and bequeath to my Son Wendell O. Winston my old Silver Spoon bequeathed to me by my father to him and his heirs forever.

5th Item. The tract of land upon which I reside called Courthouse together with my negroes, Stock of horses, mules, Cows, Sheep and hogs, farming utensils, wagon, carts, Carriages, Buggy, house hold and Kitchen furniture, plate, plated ware and Crockery. I wish kept together during the life of my wife Sarah A. Winston for the support of my said wife in her old age.

Horses, Cattle, Sheep, and large wagons, Carriages and
buggy, household & kitchen furniture plate, plated ware and
Crochery, Crops & provisions to be sold and the proceeds arising
together with my Negroes and the residue of my estate to be
equally divided between all my Children the same to be to
them in fee Simple or in Trust at the discretion of my
Executors they may at the time think best and elect to do.

5) Item. The residue of my real estate and personal estate I
wish to be sold whenever my Executors may think it best for
the interest of my estate and the proceeds to be loaned out or in-
vested in such Stocks as my Executors may think in their dis-
cretion most conducive to the interest of my estate.

6) Item. It being my wish that all my Children shall
have good educations it is my wish that no Separate Charges
shall be made against them therefore.

7) Item. It is my wish and I do hereby so direct that in
the final distribution of my estate among my Children
that each Child or Children who may have received advances must
shall be charged with the principal amount or valuation
thereof, but no interest is to be charged thereon.

Lastly. It is my will that my brother Beckwith L. Winston shall
act as Guardian of my infant Children and in this ad-
ministration shall not be limited to the profits of their estate but in
his discretion may appropriate to that object all or part of the

Lastly - It is my will that my brother Beckerton L. Winston shall
act as Guardian of my infant children and in their educa-
tion shall not be limited to the profits of their estate but in
his discretion may appropriate to that object so much of the
principal as he may think advisable. It is also my will
that Beckerton L. Winston, Philip H. Winston and Robert O. Danne
act as Executors of this my last will and Testament. In
