the name of Damsell and One red hoffer of about three years old to his
Daughter Elizabeth and her inwards

Item I give and bequeath to my Son in Law James Gates One young mare
together with all the rest of my Estate goods and Chattells not mentioned
before and I nominate and appoynt the said James Gates my Executor
of this my last will and Testament — In witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and affixt my Seal this 19th day of August 1715.
