First I Commit my Soul into the hands of Almighty God y^t gave it, hoping
 through the Meritorious death & passion of my Lord & Saviour Jesus Christ
 to Receive free pardon & forgiveness of all my sins. ~

First I will y^t all my debts & funeral charges be paid. ~

Item: I Give and bequeath to my Son John Forrest the houses & land I now
 live upon containing 150 Acres be it more or less to him & his heirs for ever,
 and in case my said Son John Forrest should happen to Die without heirs
 then the Afore said Land to fall to my daughter Phoebe Forrest, to her & her
 heirs for ever further it is my will and desire y^t my Wife Mary Forrest
 and my Daughter Phoebe Forrest shall not be molested or turned off the afore
 said Land or Plantation. I now live upon ~ Except they chance to Marry,
 then to have no more any Right or Title to it. ~

Forrest Shall come to Lawfull Age, but in case my Wife Mary Forrest should happen to Marry before my Son Jn. shall Arrive at lawfull Age.
