Item. I Give and bequeth to my Son John Forrest the houses & land I now
live upon. Containing 150 Acres be it more or less to him & his heirs for ever,
and in Case my said Son John Forrest should happen to Die without heirs
then the Aforesaid Land to fall to my daughter Phoebe Forrest, to her & her
heirs for ever further it is my will and desire y^t my Wife Mary Forrest
and my Daughter Phoebe Forrest shall not be Molested or turned off the afore
said Land or Plantation. I now live upon ~ Except they Chance to Marry,
then to have no more, any Right or Tytle to it. ~ .
