 God make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner following. first I
 Recommend my ^{over my} Soul to Almighty God that gave it and my Mortal Body to be decently
 buried at the Discretion of my Executors dated this 9th day of December Anno Domini
 1717. First I Give and Bequeath to my Brother Joseph Woodson one tract of Land on
 four mile Creek to him and his heirs for ever. Second. I Give and Bequeath to my
 Brother Joseph One hundred and Seventy Acres of Land at Dover to be laid off on the
 upper side of my Land Provided he shall Pay to my Ex^{rs} the Sum of ten pounds current
 money but if he does not Pay the said money then I Give it to my Brother Benjamin
 and his heirs for ever. Third. I Give unto my Sister Jane Woodson and her
 heirs one hundred Acres of Land at Dover being the lower part of my Land Provided
 she shall Pay to my Executors the Sum of five pounds current money but if she pays
 not the money then I Give it to my Brother Benjamin and his heirs for ever on the
 same Conditions. Fourth. I Give unto my Brother Benjamin all my Negroes house-
 hold Goods Stock and Debts to him and his heirs for ever. Fifth. I Give and Bequeath

of my Bro: Joseph to him and his heirs for ever hereby discharging my Said Cousin Tan-

my last Will and Testament in manner and form following I give and bequeath
the hands of Almightie God hoping through the meritorious death and precious blood
Saviour Jesus Christ to Receive forgiveness of all my sins and my body to be
decently buried at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter named. I give and bequeath
that my Debts and funeral Charges be paid and discharged. I give and bequeath
to my Son Robert Goode the Plantation I now live upon known by the name of Middle
training by Estimation Two hundred Acres more or less with all the appurtenances
belonging to him and his heirs for ever but in case my said Son Robert Goode should
happen to Die before he shall attain to the Age of twenty one Years or lawfull Age
aforesaid Plantation to fall to my Son Francis Goode to him and his heirs for ever.
I Give and Bequeath to my Son Francis Goode my Negro Woman named Moll to him and his
heirs for ever with her issue. Item I Give unto my Sister Anna Goode one heifer about
three Years Old, with a calf by her side to be given her at the Age of Eighteen Years
on the Day of Marriage. Item I Give unto my Son Robert Goode three young Cows
Calves and four Sows and Pigs or with Pigg. Item I Give unto my Son Francis Goode
three young Cows and calves and four Sows and Pigs or with Pigg which said Cows and calves Sows
Pigs they both shall Receive when they come to lawfull Age. Item I Give unto John Goode
the Sum of ten Shillings to be paid in any convenient Sort in the aforesaid County upon
the full following next after my Decease. Item all the Rest and Residue of my personal
Estate I Give and Bequeath to my Loving Wife Elizabeth Goode and make her full and sole
Executrix of this my last Will and Testament Revoked and Disannulled and making void
