This Will was Proved by the Oaths of Thomas Wadley (Testes)  
and Martha Hatchett three of the Witnesses thereto and there  
upon admitted to Record.

In the Name of God Amen Robert Good of the Parish and County of Gloucester being  
Weak of Body but of perfect mind and memory blessed be God for it doth make up my  
my last Will and Testament in manner and form following I first declare  
the hands of Almighty God hoping through his mercitorious death and resurrection  
Saviour Jesus Christ to Receive free pardon and forgiveness of all my sins and my body  
decously buried at the Discretion of my Executrix hereafter named. First I give and Bequeath  
that my Debt and funeral Charges be paid and defrayed as herein is required. Bequeath  
to my Son Robert Goode the Plantation Ludio his upon Execution by the value of which  
staining by Estimation the hundred Acres more or less will all the effects thereon  
belonging to him and his heirs for ever but in case my said Son Robert Goode  
die before he shall attain to the Age of twenty one Years or have a Age  
aforesaid Plantation to fall to my Son Francis Goode to him and his heirs for ever.  
I Give and Bequeath to my Son Francis Goode my Negro Woman named Mollie to him and his  
heirs for ever with her issue. Item I give unto my Sister Anna Good one boar  
three Years Old with a Calf by her side to be given her at the Age of eighteen years  
on the Day of her marriage. Item I give unto my Son Robert Goode three young  
Cales and four Sows and Pigs or with Pigg. Item I give unto my Son Francis Goode  
Cales and Calves and four Sows and Pigs or with Pigg which said Cales and Calves and  
Pigs they both shall receive when they come to full Age. Item I give unto John Green  
the sum of ten Shillings to be paid in any convenient store in the aforesaid County upon  
the last following next after my Decease. Item all the Rest and余物 of my  
Estate I Give and Bequeath to my loving Wife Elizabeth Goode and make her full and sole  
Executor of this my last Will and Testament Revoking Disantiling and making void  
all other Wills and Testaments by me herebefore made witness my hand and Seal  
this 25<sup>th</sup> Day of May Anno Dom. 1718.
