of Arthur Mosley deceased presented the Inventory and appraisement
of his late Presidents effects, which was agreed to be recorded.

Cast. Bowler Coche Esq.

In the Name of god Amen I Francis Lopes of the parish of Daler in the County of Dorset
being weak of body but of sound and disposing Mind and Memory do make and ordain this my last Will
and Testament in Manner and form following In witness I commit myself to god who giveth
and count me my Body unto the earth by decent Burying at the Direction of my executors hereinafter
After named, afforeward trusting in the Mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ for eternal salvation after
Day of his resurrection and accounting my worldly effects with what it shall please god to bestow upon me,
I give and dispose of these and as follows etc. And I give Divis and Bequests all my lands in Brimoddy hundred
to my dear and loving Master during his Natural life, with all houses and orchards thereunto belonging
and after his death to my loving Brother Richard Lopes and his heirs forever, On condition my said Brother
Richard Lishes & shall let my Brother William Lopes his son & postively and quietly enjoy all that
land etc. etc.
