 Thomas Bailey late of Henrico County but now of Prince William of the  
 one part and Richard Randolph of the County of Henrico of the other  
 Part Witnesseth that the said Thomas Bailey for divers good causes  
 & considerations but more especially for the Consideration of two hundred  
 Pounds current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said  
 Richard Randolph the Receipt whereof he the said Thomas Bailey  
 doth hereby acknowledge hath given granted Bargained & Sold All  
 Inscroffed & confirmed unto the said Richard Randolph his Heirs and  
 Assigns for ever one Tract of Land situate Lying & being in the County  
 & Parish of Henrico & on the North Side James River at a Place called the  
 Worlds End containing two hundred Acres be the same more or less  
 which said Land was formerly the Inheritance of Thomas Bailey late of  
 Henrico County Deceased who by his last Will & Testament devised the  
 same to Thomas Bailey his Son & Heir who is party to this Deed & all houses  
 Edifices Buildings Orchards Trees Woods Underwoods ways Waters Water  
 Courses Easements Profits Commodities Advantages Emoluments and  
 Hereditaments whatsoever to the said Premises or any part thereof belonging  
 or in any wise appertaining And also the reversion & reversionary remain-  
 der and Remainders of all and singular the said Premises of every Part  
 and Parcel thereof with the Appurtenances and also all the Estate Right
