This Indenture made the fifth Day of September one thousand and forty six between Walter Scott of the County of Henrico of the one part and Philip Mayo of the same County of the other part Witnesses that the said Walter Scott for and in Consideration of the sum of one Hundred & fifty six pounds Current Money of Virginia to him in hand paid the Receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge Hath granted bargained sold aliened Enfeofed & Confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien Enfeof & Confirm unto the said Philip Mayo his Heirs & Assigns for ever one certain Parcel of Land in the County of Henrico on the South side of James River on the back of Warwick containing by Estimation Three Hundred and fifteen Acres be the same more or less & so the said and Fifty part of the said Three Hundred & Fifteen Acres being granted to the said Walter Scott by Patent bearing date the Twentieth day of October one Thousand Seven Hundred and Four the the other Sixty five Acres he the said Walter Scott bought of Samuel Gode adjoining the Lands of William Byrd Esq<sup>r</sup>. Norham Eastley and the said Tract of two Hundred & fifty Acres and all the Estate Right Title interest Use Trust property claim & Demand of him
