I the Name of god Amos I Francis Ippes of the parish of St. Peter, in the County of Monmouth being weak of Body but of sound and disposing Mind and Memory do make and contain this My last Will and Testament in Manner and form following Inprimis I commit my Soul to god who gave it and commit my Body unto the earth by decent Burialling at the Discretion of my Executors hereinafter Named, assuredly Trusting in the Mercy of Jesus Christ my Redeemer for Eternal Salvation, at the Day of the Resurrection and touching my worldly Goods with what it hath pleased God to bestow upon me, I give and dispose thus, As followeth. I have given my Wife and Bequeste all my Lands in Barmosy Hundred to my Dear and Loving Mother during her Natural Life, with all Houses and Orchards & Tenements belonging and appertaining to her as to my Loving Brother Richard Ippes and his heirs forever, On Condition my said Brother Richard his heirs & assigns shall let my Brother William Ippes his heirs & assigns peaceably and quietly enjoy all that Part of Land lying in Monmouth County and parish known by the Name of Longfield and now in my possession which was given me by my father, but if my Brother Richard Ippes his heirs & assigns at any time shall offend my Brother William Ippes his heirs & assigns of their quiet possession of a in part of Longfield then I give that Land which belonged to Thomas Jones which my father purchased and divides thereof of his Land in Barmosy Hundred to my Brother William Ippes and his heirs forever. I have given my Wife and Bequeste to my Loving Brother William Ippes all my Land at Longfield and that which was purchased of Robert Britton also one half of my Land at Shire Quarter to have the plantation now sowed in his part to him and his heirs for ever. I have given my Wife and Bequeste to my Loving Brother Richard Ippes the other half of my Land at Shire Quarter to be divided equally in quantity and Quality to him and his heirs forever. I have given my Wife and Bequeste to my Loving Brother Thomas Ippes one Negro Boy Tom, one Negro Girl named Hannah, also one hundred and fifty

pounds current Money and one half of Fawcett's lot and her line forever. Now I give and Bequeath to my loving Sister Martha Lpper two Negroes named Kate and Betty also one hundred and fifty pounds current Money and One set of Silver Caskets to her and her heirs forever. Now my Will and desire is that the several Negroes be continued at the several plantations where they were residing and that the profits by their labour after their Maintenance be towards raising the Money given my Sister. My Will is that the Negroes Tom, Phoebe, Kate, Cooper, Rachell, Harry, Phoebe and Tuck remain at their quarters, Pompey and Abraham at the Mountain tractable York, Betty and Poll at Longfield. Now I give Poise and Bequeath the above named Negroes living at their quarters, the Mountain and Longfield and their Quarters to be equally divided between my Brother Richard and William Lpper and their heirs forever. Now I give Poise and Bequeath to my Sister Sarah Lpper my Negro Man named Jack to him and his heirs forever. Now I give Poise and Bequeath to my Dear and loving Mother my Negro Man named Langton, Tim, Dick, Charles, Lewis and my Negrotary Mordling to her and her heirs forever also two other Beds and furniture which my father gave me. Now I give Poise and Bequeath to my loving Brother Richard Lpper my Silver and Silver Tankard, My Silver Chalice and Chalice, My Cropping Saddle and furniture. Now I give Poise and Bequeath to my loving Brother William Lpper my Scrubbed with glass Pewee also one New Cropping Saddle and furniture. Now I give Poise and Bequeath to Capt. Charles Adlam if he comes to Virginia my young horse sold and two Guinea's to buy him a Morning Ring. Now I give Poise and Bequeath to my Brother Richard and William my land in South and County near the Mountains to be divided equally between them, them and their heirs forever. Now my Will and desire is that my Estate be so appraised. Now I give Poise and Bequeath all the rest of my Estate to my Dear and loving Mother Sarah Lpper, whom I do hereby Nominate, constitute and Appoint my Executrix of this my last Will and Testament in which Will of I have herunto set my hand and seal the twenty fourth Day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and thirty six Signed And Sealed in presence of
