

In the name of god amen I George Freeman of <sup>the</sup> parish and County of Henrico do make this my last Will and Testament as followeth (viz<sup>th</sup>) first I bequeath my Soul to god and my Body to be buried and all my worldly Dels to be justly paid Item I give and bequeath one certain Tract of Land which I hold under several Surveyes amounting to one thousand Six hundred and eight Acres to be Divided and distributed in manner and form as followeth and the said Tract of Land is lying and being in <sup>the</sup> parish and County of Henrico where I now live Item I leave to my Daughter Bells Freeman during her Natural life one certain parcel of the above named Tract of Land beginning on Buck Meadow in Randolph line thence up the said Meadow and continuing the same course untill it meet my back line the said Tract or parcel of Land containing by Estimate one hundred acres or be there more or less to her my said Daughter during her Natural life and afterward to the heirs of her Body lawfully begotten and if she should Die without Heir the said Land to be to my Son Joseph his heirs or assigns Item I give unto my Son George Freeman one certain parcel of the aforesaid Tract of Land containing by Estimate three hundred Acres or be there more or less beginning on buck Meadow and running thence a straight course to the mouth of Scraping Branch southerly the said Branch untill it meets my back line to him my said Son Geo his heirs or assigns Item I give to my Son John Freeman one certain parcel of the said Tract of Land containing by Estimate three hundred Acres or be their more or less beginning on the East side the flat Branch at the place where George's line crosses the said Branch thence down the said Branch to Randolph line and so including all y<sup>e</sup> end of my Survey to him my son John his heirs or assigns Item I give to my Son Joseph Freeman the plantation and wherein I now live with the remaining part of my Survey of Land to him my Son Joseph his heirs or assigns Item I leave and hand over of Land wherein John Shoemaker now lives to be finally made over unto the said Shoemaker by Deed of Sale by my Executors Item I give unto my Son in law Thomas Sphlin and his Wife my Daughter Hannah Sphlin one certain parcel of the said Tract of Land beginning on John Shoemakers line after his land is laid off and running thence along Shoemakers line northerly about four to five Rods thence down the said Run to Randolph line to them my Son in law and daughter during their Natural lives and after their Deaths to my Grandson James Sphlin Son to the said Thomas and Hannah Sphlin to him his heirs or assigns Item I give to my Son Holman Freeman all the remainder of my aforesaid Tract of Land to him his heirs or assigns Item I give to my Son George Freeman & young Negro named Will to him his heirs or assigns Item I give to my Son Holman Freeman & Negro boy named Lewis to him his heirs or assigns Item I leave to my Daughter Bells Freeman & Negro girl named Nan to her and her heirs Item I leave to my Son in law Thomas Sphlin and my Daughter Hannah Sphlin & Negro girl named Judy to them during their lives and afterward to the heirs of her Body lawfully begotten Item I give to my loving wife Jane Freeman one Negroman named Tom and a Negro girl named Phely to her during her Natural life and afterward that is after her Death I give and bequeath the said Negro man named Tom to my Son John Freeman his heirs or assigns and I give and bequeath the said Negro girl named Phely to my Son George Freeman his heirs or assigns Item I give and bequeath to my four Sons Namely George Holman John and Joseph and my two Daughters Hannah and Bell's each of them Two Cow and Calves & Two Pigs and Pigs Item I give and bequeath all of my estate in what manner and form soever it be unto my loving wife Jane Freeman and I do appoint my said Wife and my Son George Freeman and my Son Holman Freeman Trusty Executors of this my last Will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal the third day of October in the year of our Lord 1795

Item I give unto my Son George Freeman one certain parcel of the aforesaid Tract of Land containing by Estimate three hundred Acres or be there more or less beginning on Buck Meadow and running thence a straight course to the mouth of scraping Branch southerly the said Branch until it meets my back line to him my said Son George his heirs or assigns. Item I give to my Son John his man one certain parcel of the said Tract of Land containing by Estimate three hundred Acres or be there more or less beginning on the Lash Side the flat Branch at the place where George is line crosses the said Branch thence down the said Branch to Randolph line and so including all the end of my Survey to him my son John his heirs or assigns. Item I give to my Son Joseph Freeman the plantation and wherein I now live will all the remaining part of my Survey of Land to him my son Joseph his heirs or assigns. Item I leave and bequeath all the rest of Land wherein John Shoemaker now lives to be fairly made over unto the said Shoemaker by Deed of Sale by my Executors. Item I give unto my Son in law Thomas Sypkin and his Wife my Daughter Hannah Sypkin one certain parcel of the said Tract of Land beginning on John Shoemakers line after his land is laid off and running thence along Shoemakers line and so on thence about four to Day Plantation thence down the said Run to Randolph line to them my Son in law and daughter during their Natural lives and after their Deaths to my Grandson James Sypkin Son to the said Thomas and Hannah Sypkin to him his heirs or assigns. Item I give to my Son Holman Freeman all the remainder of my aforesaid Tract of Land to him his heirs or assigns. Item I give to my Son George Freeman & young Negro named Will to him his heirs or assigns. Item I give to my Son Holman Freeman & Negro boy named Lewis to him his heirs or assigns. Item I leave to my Daughter Ollie Freeman & Negro girl named Nancy to her and her heirs. Item I leave to my Daughter Hannah Sypkin & Negro girl named Judy to them during their lives and afterward to the heirs of her Body lawfully begotten.

Item I give to my loving wife Sarah Freeman one Negroman named Tom and a Negro girl named Phely to her during her Natural life and afterward that is after her Death I give and bequeath the said Negroman named Tom to my son John my son the Freeman his heirs or assigns and I give and bequeath the said Negro girl named Phely to my Son Joseph Freeman his heirs or assigns. Item I give and bequeath to my four Sons Namely George Holman John and Joseph and my two Daughters Hannah and Ollie each of them Two Cow and Calves & Two Sows and Pigs. Item I give and bequeath all of my estate in what manner and form soever it be unto my loving wife Sarah Freeman and I do appoint my said wife and my son George Freeman and my son Holman Freeman jointly Executors of this my last Will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the third day of October in the year
