This Deed was proved to be the act and Deed of Thomas East by his oaths of Amos Liphrot &
Solemn Affirmation of Thomas Childers a Quaker and was thereupon admitted to record.

In the Name of God Amen August y^e twenty seventh in y^e year of our Lord Christ one
thousand seven hundred & twenty six Henry Randolph of the parish of Bristol & County of
Touristo. being sick & weak of body. but of sound & perfect mind & memory praised be to all
mighty God for the same. doo make and ordain this to be my last will & Testament in manner
and form following (viz^t) first I recommend my soul to almighty God who gave it me & my
body to the Earth from whence it was taken to be buried in such & decent & Christian manner as
my Excutrix hereafter mentioned shall think most convenient and as touching my worldly
estate wth y^e Lord in his mercy hath sent me my will and meaning is the same shall be employed
and bestowed in manner & form following I then Give unto my Daughter Sarah Randolph and
her heirs for ever one tract or parcel of Land lying in touristo County on the upper Swanpoutain
bearing date the 21st of October one thousand six hundred & eighty seven Likewise give unto my said
Daughter Sarah and her heirs for ever one negro boy named Liferoller, one Mulatto boy named Will
one negro woman named Hannah & one negro girl named Moll together with their increase
I then Give unto my Daughter Anne Randolph & her heirs for ever five hundred and fifty acres
of Land lying in touristo County on the South Side of Swift Creek Likewise give unto my said Daughter
Anne and her heirs for ever four negroes and their increase viz^t York Tommy boy, Phillis & her Child
Phoebe. I then Give unto my Son Henry Randolph & his heirs for ever one negro boy named Robin
one Mulatto boy named Daniel one Mulatto girl named Bess with her increase and twenty pounds
Curr^t money I then Give unto my Son Francis Randolph & his heirs for ever one tract or parcel of
Land lying in prince Georges County on the border branch containing one Thousand and fifty three
acres I also give unto my s^d Son Francis and his heirs for ever three Negroes and their increase viz^t
Little Phillis Agnes & Sus & twenty pounds Curr^t money. I then. my will is that my two negroes
women, Tommy and Judith with all their increase from this time be Equally Divided betwix my
two Sons Henry and Francis and if either of them dy before they arrive to the age of twenty one years
that then the survivor to enjoy the whole of this Legacy I then Give to my wife viz^t Randolph
During her widowhood the use and occupation of all my Land within the following bounds viz^t beginning
at a white oaks at the bark Creek being the beginning of my Land, thence into the woods to

Walthals corner oak thence on featherstone line to Statters run & so down the said run to Swift Creek
Thence I give unto my said wife Elizabeth & her heirs for ever all the rest of my personal Estate & negroes
not already mention lastly I hereby constitute & appoint my S. Loving wife Eliza. Randolph whole
and sole executrix of this my last will & Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and affixed my seal the day and year above written
