thousand Seven hundred & Twenty six. Henry Randolph of the parish of Bristol & County of
Kenrico. being sick & weak of body, but of sound & perfect mind & memory praised be God.
mighty God for the same. doth make and ordain this to be my last will & Testament in manner
and form following (viz) first I recommend my soul to almighty God who gave it me & my
body to this earth from whence it was taken to be buried in such decent & Christian manner as
my Executrix hereafter mentioned shall think most convenient and as touching my worldly
estate w^t y^r Lord in his mercy hath sent me my will and meaning is the same shall be employed
and bestowed in manner & form following. Item I give unto my Daughter Sarah Randolph and
her heirs for ever one tract or parcel of Land lying in Kenrico County on the athen Swamp contain-
ing two hundred and fifty acres the said Land being formerly granted to Samuel Fowler by patent
bearing date the 21st of October one thousand six hundred & eighty seven I likewise give unto my said
Daughter Sarah and her heirs for ever one negro boy named Peter, one Mulatto boy named Will
one negro woman named Hannah one negro girl named Nell together with their increase —
Item I give unto my Daughter Anne Randolph & her heirs for ever five hundred and fifty acres
of Land lying in Kenrico County on the south side of Swift Creek I likewise give unto my said Daughter
Anne and her heirs for ever four negroes and their increase viz. York, Tommy boy, Phillis, & her child
Phoebe. Item I give unto my Son Henry Randolph his heirs for ever one Negroe boy named Robin
one Mulatto boy named Daniel one Mulatto girl named Bess with her increase and Twenty pounds
curr. money. Item I give unto my Son Francis Randolph his heirs for ever one tract or parcel of
Land lying in Prince George County on Bobrdam branch containing one thousand and fiftynine
acres I also give unto my s^r. Son Francis and his heirs for ever three Negroes and their increase viz
Little Phillis Agnes & two & Twenty pounds curr. money. Item. my will is that my two Negroes —
woman, Tommy, and Judith with all their increase from this time be Equally Divided between my
two Sons Henry and Francis and if either of them die before they arrive to the age of twenty one years
that then the survivor to enjoy the whole of this Legacy. Item I give to my wife Eliz. Randolph —
During her widow hood his up and occupation of all my land within the following bounds viz beginning
at a white oak at the back Creek being the beginning of my land, thence into the woods to —
