 Locke the Plantation Malborn Mills and my Plantation at fore
 mile Creek after the Death of his Father James Locke None
 I give all the Rest of my Estate to be Divided between my son
 James Locke and Chasteen Locke when he arriveth to age of
 twenty one lastly I appoint my son James Locke my hole Ex^r
 sole Ex^r to this my Last will and Testament as Witness my
 hand this Nineteenth day of August 1747.
