 recorded the Particulars that are in that bond to be given by my  
 Ex<sup>r</sup> when Required according to the true intent of the bond.  
 Item I give and bequeath after the Death of my wife my Gran  
 daughter Martha Cocke four young Negro Girls not under  
 twelve years of age. Item I give unto my grandson Chasteen  
 Cocke the Plantation Malborn Hills and my Plantation at fore  
 mile Creek after the Death of his Father James Cocke Item  
 I give all the rest of my Estate to be Divided between my son  
 James Cocke and Chasteen Cocke when he ariseth to age of  
 twenty one lastly I appoint my son James Cocke my hole &  
 sole Ex<sup>r</sup> to this my Last will and Testament as witness my  
 hand this Nineteenth day of August 1717.
