the Oath of Thomas Tabb, Edward Booker Jun^r & Philip Mayo three
of the Witnesses here to be admitted to record.

In the Name of God AMEN the eighth day of
March in the year of our Lord Christ one Thousand seven
hundred and forty six I James Thompson of the Parish
of Dale and County of Henrico being sick and weak of body
but of sound and perfect mind and memory thanks be given
to God for the same doe Ordaine Constitute & appoint this to be
my last Will and Testament in manner & form following
First I recommend my Soul to God that made me hoping
through the death of my Saviour & Redeemer jesus Christ

to receive pardon & remission of all my sins of my body to the
Earth from whence it was taken in such decent manner -
as to my executors hereafter named shall think most convenient
as to my worldly goods I dispose of in manner & form
following. First I desire my just debts be duly paid and
discharged Secondly my desire is that after my debts are
all paid and discharged the residue of my Estate to be equally
Divided Vizt one half to my wife Mary and the other half
to my Daughter Anne Lastly I constitute and appoint my
Loving wife Mary and my son in Law Isham Randolph
executors of this my last Will and Testament In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal
the day & year above written.
