as to my Execut^{ors} hereafter named shall think meet & conveni-
ent & as to my worldly goods I dispose of in manner & form
following. First I desire my just debts be duly paid and
discharged Secondly my desire is that after my debts are
all paid and discharged the residue of my Estate to be equally
Divided Viz^t one half to my wife Mary and the other half
to my Daughter Anne Lastly I constitute and appoint my
Loving wife Mary and my son in Law Isham Randolph
Executors of this my last Will and Testament. In Witness
