In the name of God amen. I Jeffrey Robinson of the County of Henrico being of perfect mind and memory do first make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and following suit. I commit my soul into the hands of Almighty God saving me through the mercifulnesse Death and judgment of my Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ to receive free pardon and remission of all my sins and my Day I commit the same to be decently Interred at the Disposition of my Executor hereafter named. In witness whereof I give unto my son William Robinson five pounds. Also pay him I give devise and bequeath to my said son William Robinson two hundred acres of Land lying upon Edward Mathews at Shinewater where he now liveth part of six hundred and fifty acres purchased of Gilbert Brainerd to him the said William and to the heirs of his body lawfully begotten forever. Item the remainder of the said tract of the said Land I give Devise and bequeath to my son Richard Robinson with all buildings where I am now resident and live and the Mill and all other appurtenances therunto belonging to him the said Richard and to the heirs of his body lawfully begotten forever. Item I give devise and bequeath to my son Law John Hudson and his wife Anne and to the heirs of their bodies lawfully begotten forever the one half of a Survey of land of four hundred Acres lying upon William Bush and Thomas Bush Esq the late Mathews. Item the other half of the said Survey of Land I give Devise and bequeath to my sons James John and Thomas Robinson to them the said John and Thomas and the heirs of their bodies lawfully begotten forever. Item I give Devise and bequeath to my two Sons Jeffrey Robinson and George Robinson the one half of a Survey of land lying between James Gates and to them the said Jeffrey and George and the heirs of their bodies lawfully begotten forever Item all the remaining part of my Land not by these given I desire to be sold at the moste easie rate in a Regale or some other Conveniente rate for the use of my Children to be equally divided amongst them after the marriage or death of my wife Elizabeth my only. She to have the use thereof during her lifehood. Item I give unto my Daughter Martha Robinson one Shilling Sterling. Item I desire that all my personal Estate not already given shall be equally divided amongst my wife and all my children except my son William and Daughter Martha I having given them before what I intend them and I do make and ordain my son William Robinson Esq of this my last Will and Testament witness my hand and seal this 21st day of October 1734 A.D. *Jeffrey Robinson* *Seal*
