

In the Name of God Amen I John Baugh of the County of Henrico being at this present time in sound
and perfect sense and memory praised be God Do make & ordain this my Last will and Testament in
manner & form following. Viz I bequeath my soul to God that gave it me hoping through the merits of my
blessed Saviour and Redeemer Jesus Christ to receive full pardon of all my sins & a joyful resurrection
to Eternal bliss & happiness and my body to the Earth to be decently buried according to the Discretion
of my Executors hereafter named and my real & personal Estate after my Just Debts paid I give &
Dispose of the same as followeth (Viz) I give & bequeath unto my son John Baugh one half or moiety
of all my Lands & the plantation on pierces Hills Creek & to his heirs for ever. Except forty acres. I give
and bequeath unto my son Henry Baugh and his heirs for ever the other half or moiety of all my Lands
and the plantation now lies on, upon the river except forty acres. and if it should please God that
one of my s^{on}s should dye wth out Lawfull heirs then such part of the said Land to return to the sur-
viving brother and his heirs for ever & for want of such heirs all my s^{on}s Lands to return and be to my
two Daughters Mary & Hannah Baugh & to their heirs for ever. I give unto my son John Baugh
one sealed Ring one Gum and one set of silver buttons marked J B. I give unto my son Henry
one Gum. I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Ann and to my Daughter Martha and to my
Daughter Sarah to each of them one shilling they having already rec^d their portions. I give and
bequeath unto my Daughter Mary the wife of Henry Walters one Cow & Calf. I give and bequeath
to my Daughter Hannah one Cow and Calf. I give & bequeath all the rest of my Estate to my Loving w^{ife}
Margret and to her Disposing viz Lands goods Chattels & all whatsoever shall be mine and do
heretby make & constitute my s^{on} wife my whole & sole Execut^r of this my Last will in witness where-
of I have herunto putt my hand & seal this twentieth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand
and seven hundred and fourteen.
