Kintle to him & his heirs for ever I give & bequeath my Granddaughter Prudence Amos fully running wth y^e. mare with her Increase I give and bequeath to my Granddaughter Jane the Daughter of my son Robert according to the s^d. her Increase I give & bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Kintle a ring of 15 Shilling price I give to my son J^r. the beds wth 2 pots &c. now in his possession I give to my son Robert the five beds & the 2 smaller pots & one Walnut Table wth a Draw in it now in his possession I give & bequeath to my s^d. wife Sarah

as also make Constituted & ordain my s^r wife to be whole & sole Executrix of this my Last will and Testament thereby

be taken according to the true intent & meaning thereof this third Day of December Anno Domini 1725.
