Testaments as followeth. First I commend my Soul to god Almighty
and my Boddy To be Desently Buried by my Executors here after Nam-
ed Item I give & bequesth unto my loving wife Sarah Brumall the Plantation
whereon I now live Such quantity of Land From a great Branch Called
Manfields Run & on the North Side of falling Creek thence Running up
the S. Creek To a Branch Running through the Cornfields thence
that course to the Race Path to the old line only she to have

the use of the townfield that is over the S. Branch her life time and after
the old line to the Branch called Mansfield where first began to be
at her disposal And all my Personal Estate I give unto my loving
wife Except some things I shall mention Item I give to my John the
remainder part of ^{my} Land from ~~the~~ Reedy Run down to the Branch that
Divides he and his Mother to him and his heirs for ever Item I give
and bequeath to my Son William the land ^(that) is below the S. Branch Cal
Mansfields and so down S. falling Creek to the first Branch below S
Mansfields thence running up the S Branch to white Oakes in a head
of a bottom where formerly stood a black gum to him and his heirs
for ever, Item I give and bequeath to David man all the land below the S
Branch that I give my Son William all the Lower part of the S. Land
to him and his heirs for ever Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter
martha ^{one} feather bed and furniture and one Cow and calf to her
and her heirs for ever Item I give bequeath to my loving wife Sarah
Broomall half of the Tract of Land lying and being at a place called
the hole Pit to be at her disposal to give to home she Pleases Item I give
and bequeath to my Daughter hannah one shilling to her and her heirs
for ever Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Ruth one shilling
to her and her heirs for ever Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter
Mary one shilling to her and her heirs for ever Item I give and bequest
to my Daughter Sarah one shilling to her and her heirs for ever
and it is my desire that my Estate shall not be Praised Lastly

I appoint my loving Wife Sarah Brammell my Heir and Sole Ex-
 ecutor of this my last Will here by Revoking all other Will or Wills by
 me heretofore made In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
 Seal this twentieth Six day of February one Thousand Seven hundred and
 forty Six: Seven.
