Harwood Guardian of John Bullington the Said Gardiner paying the Said Harwood for the Use of the Said Orphan the Sum of Two Pounds Twelve Shillings & four Pence half Penny out of the Personall Estate in his hands Given under our hands this the Third Day of January 1731.
