

In the Name of god amen John Cannon Senior of the county of Henrico being sick and weak in Body but of sound and perfect memory praised be god for the Same and knowing the uncertainty of this life on earth and being desirous to settle things in order do make this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say first and principally I commend my Soul to almighty god my Creator assuredly believing that I shall receive free pardon and free remission of all my sins and be saved by the precious death and merits of my blessed redeemer Jesus Christ and my Body to the earth from whence it was taken to be buried in such decent and Christian manner as to my Executors hereafter named shall be thought meet and convenient and as Touching such worldly Estate as the Lord in mercy hath lent me my Will & meaning is the same shall be employed and bestowed as hereafter by this my Will is expressed and first I do revoke, frustrate and make void all Wills by me formerly made and declare and appoint this my last Will and Testament. First I will that all my Just Debts Legacies and funeral expences be well and truly paid after my Decas by my Executors hereafter named. Item I give and bequeath to my Son John Cannon my plantation and the Land thereto belonging where I now live also one feather Bed and Furniture, one Iron pot containing eight Gallons two plates Dishes two plates one Gun called the Bullet Gun two young Cows one young Bay mare two years old and one great Chick when he attains to the age of eighteen years. Item I give and bequeath to my Son William Cannon one Bed and furniture, one Iron pot containing three Gallons two pewther Dishes two plates one Gun called the Brachaneer Gun one Cow one young Mare one little Chest. Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Cannon one black mare branded. S. Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Jane the life of Samuel pimeham one Shilling. Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary the life of John Cannon one Shilling. Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah one young black Horse unbranded. Lastly I give unto my loving Wife Mary all the rest residue and remainder of my said personal Estate of what kind soever the same during her life and here but in case she should happen to marry then it is my Will and mind that the said Estate so given to her as abovesaid shall be equally divided among my said three Children John William and Sarah and lastly I do hereby appoint my said loving Wife John pimeham and Abraham Childers Executors of this my last Will and Testament hoping they will faithfully and duly performed as my Trust in them is reposed. In witness whereof I have hereunto set this my last Will and Testament at my hand and Seal this fifth day of January one thousand seven hundred and thirty and Two.
