 Cesar, Amy, Josh, Peter, Betty, Olive, Tom to him and his heirs forever. To have and to hold the said Tract of Land and
 Negroes and every part thereof with all houses, Orchards, Woods waters libertys privileges and immunities whatsoever
 to the same belonging without any hindrance or molestation from the said George Robertson the father his heirs Executors
