 Thereunto him moving but more especially for y. him often pounds curr^t money to him in hand paid
 by y. S. John y. resp. whereof he doth ~~acknowledge~~ acknowledge & him self therewith fully paid hath granted &
 bargained aliened enfeoffed & confirmed & by these presents doth grant bargain enfeoff & confirm
 unto y. S. John Minns & his heirs for ever one tract or parcel of Land lying in the above said County & bounding
 on both sides Licking hole creek containing one hundred & seventy nine acres of Land bounded as followeth
 beginning at a white & red oak former thence N. 29 East one hundred and sixty chain to a former pine
 thence on y. S. David line East two degrees North fifty chain to a former white oak & pine thence South twenty
 nine degrees west one hundred & sixty chain to a former white oak & pine thence west two degrees South on y.
