 by y. S. John y. roesp. wherof he doth ~~not~~ ~~not~~ acknowledge him self or with fully paid hath granted &
 Bargained aliened Enfeoffed & confirmed & by these presents doth grant bargain Enfeoff & confirm &
 unto y. S. John Mims this tenement or parcell of land lying in the above said County & bounded
 on both sides ditching hole creek containing one hundred Seventy nine acres of Land bounded as follows
 beginning at a white & red oak corner thence N. E. 29 East one hundred and Sixty chain to a former pine
 thence on y. S. David line East two degrees North fifty chain to a former white oak & pine thence South twenty
