I thought it was prudent of me to make my will Testament in manner and form as followeth. first I resign my soul to God who gave it to me in hopes of pardon and Remission of sins by the merits and passion of my Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ and my body to be buried according to the direction of my Executors hereafter named I am I Dutart by this my will and Testament that my dear and well beloved wife Barbara Dutart shall have During her Natural life the possession of the plantation wheron I now Dwell with all the appurtenances thereto belonging and situated on the south side of James River containing as by Estimation Sixty one acres lying between John Jovany & Stephen Chaffain with four hundred acres of land lying and situated on the great branch of the Manokin river Creek.
