I thought it was prudence of me to make my will & Testament in manner and form as followeth. First I Resign my Soul to God who gave it to me in hopes of pardon and Remission of sins by the merits and passion of my Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ and my body to be buried according to the Discretion of my Executors hereafter named I Bin I declare by this my will and Testament that my dear and well beloved wife Barbara Dutoit shall have During her Natural Life the possession of the plantation whereon I now dwell with all the appurtenances thereto belonging and Situate on the south side of James River containing as by Estimation Sixty one acres lying between John Jovany & Stephen Chaffain with four hundred acres of land lying and Situate on the great branch of the Manokin in upper Creek
